Question 1: "Shall the Town of Otis be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the borrowing issued in order to pay costs of designing, constructing and furnishing a new Library, including the payment of all other costs incidental and related thereto?"

Question 2: "Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year 2022 entitled 'An Act establishing recall elections in the town of Otis' be accepted?"

The special act provides for a recall petition to be issued upon the filing of an affidavit with the town clerk signed by at least one hundred voters. The affidavit shall state the grounds for recall and the clerk shall submit the affidavit to the board of registrars to certify that the affidavit is signed by registered voters. Following certification, a petition for recall will be issued by the town clerk and 30 percent of registered voters must sign the petition for the recall vote to proceed. If the petition is filed and certified by the board of registers to be sufficient, written notice will be issued to the official. If the official does not resign within 7 days, an election will be held in the form prescribed in the Act.
