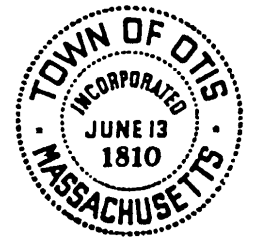

TOWN OF OTIS SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION

Requirements:

1. MUST BE OTIS RESIDENT
2. MUST APPLY NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2020

This scholarship will be awarded to one or more Otis students graduating from a high school in Massachusetts, who plans to continue his/her education by attending a full time advanced educational institution for two or more years. This will include technical schools, community college and four year college or university.

Requirements are a letter from the applicant requesting consideration for the scholarship.

Suggested information to be included in letter is on page two. The committee must receive this letter and application no later than April 1, 2020.

The award will be announced at the senior awards ceremony and given upon proof the student has completed the first semester by passing all subjects and has enrolled for the second semester. We encourage all graduating students from Otis to apply.
